- Lack of competent staff
- High degree of Digitisation
- Infrastructure issues
- Operational / Technical challenges Choices to make.





### Developments that touch our industry

- Climate Change discussion and government decisions
  - CO2 reduction
  - Changing product handling
- Actual geopolitical situation
- Environment in general pressure from residential areas
- Port Authorities driven by 'symbol policy'
- Changing product portfolio to be handled restructuring of terminals
- High steel and raw materials pricing / Effects to our investments
- Concentration in industry buying behaviour
- Others, e.g.:
  - Human Capital
  - Alcohol and Drugs abuse
  - Digitisation





### **Examples**

- Change of power use at terminals
- Shore electricity for vessels
- Coal export terminal in Canada restructuring to biomass
- Major redefinition of West European coal terminals
- Warehouses in spite of 'open space storage'
- Closed conveyor belts in spite of truck transport
- Dust protection by conveyor belts
- Complete dust reducing coverage systems
